WHAT IS CAMP H.E.A.R. ?

Camp H.E.A.R. is a one-of-a-kind retreat designed specifically for children with hearing loss and their families. The entire family is invited to attend and spend the weekend at one of our amazing partner camps. **Camp H.E.A.R.: Long View** is located in east Tennessee along the winding Nolichucky River, with beautiful views of the Great Smoky Mountains. **Camp H.E.A.R. – BLUE SPRINGS** is located on the FL panhandle in Marianna FL an hour north of Panama City Beach. We have also partnered with **East Tennessee State University** in Johnson City TN to offer a weeklong **Listening and Spoken Language Day Camp** to serve our youngest campers! Best of all Camp H.E.A.R. events are offered at **NO COST** thanks to our donors, sponsors, and the hard work of the Waiting to Hear fundraising team.

Children will get to participate in traditional summer camp activities, as well as a few special surprises along the way. Meanwhile parents will have the opportunity to attend free optional workshops and seminars and meet other families who share their unique challenges. Representatives from hearing aid and cochlear implant companies as well as local hearing loss organizations will be on hand to answer questions.
